1. *Feel like revenge? Has anything happened to you that makes you feel like taking revenge? What is your answer to that feeling? Where does God fit into this situation?*

2. *Have you ever been rejected—for doing right? Rejection may be for doing right not for doing wrong. Standing alone may mean you suffer! How do you feel?*

3. *Does success make you popular? Samson was hugely successful—did that bring him friends? Why do we think we'll be better by being successful? What do you think?*

4. *Where does God fit in? Samson said two revealing things that speak of his view of God. First, he gave God the credit. Second, he called out to God when he was in need. Where is God in my life? Do I give him—my all?*
